**B**order counties in Texas and Arizona are being overrun by criminal trespassers that harass local landowners and threaten their livelihood.

Illegal aliens come into these counties from nearby Mexico by the tens of thousands each month. They then trespass across the ranchers' lands in order to evade law enforcement. In the process, they are cutting fences, severing water lines, stealing vehicles and livestock, breaking into homes, and assaulting the landowners.

County law enforcement in these areas has been overwhelmed by this invasion. The respective state governments have refused to send law enforcement assistance where it is needed most and the federal government plays politics by deliberately understaffing the US Border Patrol nationwide. The major news media has refused to air the graphic video of hordes of illegals trespassing across private property. The county attorneys in these border areas have so far refused to prosecute these criminals.
