

15. That these Officials suggested that I establish contact with other inmates in the jail to "put the word out" about the "hit" on Rolando Cruz.
16. That these other inmates were to receive visits from outside the jail to "put the word out on the street".
17. That these officials also stated that they would insure that any visits I received would not be recorded in the visitors log.
18. That these Officials also stated that an interview room at the States Attorneys' office could be made available if needed.
19. That in November of 1995, Carlos Rodriguez who was known to me as a Street Gang Crimes Intelligence Investigator, came into my cell in the Du Page County Jail.
20. That he told me "I know why you are here".
21. That thinking he was with the other Officials, I told him "if you know why I am here, then why are you sweating me?"
22. That Deputy Rodriguez stated, "he was not with that, and that he was not going to stand around and watch anyone get hurt".
23. That I told Deputy Rodriguez that I could not "Squash" anything with a "Kite" (hand written letter) and that I needed a "face to face".
24. That Deputy Rodriguez arranged a meeting with other inmates, Michael Hener, Rickey Smith and Juan Castro.
25. That I told the other inmates at the meeting that there was to be "no violence."
26. That several days after the meeting I was taken to an interview room where I met with Sergeant Wick and Detective Asmussen who stated that they were directed by Sheriff Doria to conduct an internal affairs investigation.
27. That I was told at that time that Deputy Rodriguez had filed a complaint.
28. That I told these investigators everything, how I was approached at the Menard Correctional Center, how I was transferred to the Du page County jail, how Officials wanted Rolando Cruz killed and how Deputy Rodriguez had prevented the violence.
29. That on Monday May 7, 2001 I received an Attorney visit from Attorney Linda L. Spak and Carlos Rodriguez.
