


30. That immediately following the attorney visit two Sheridan Correctional Supervisors interrogated me.
31. That these Correctional Supervisors continued to ask me what I told Attorney Spak and Carlos Rodriguez during the Attorney visit.
32. That I was scheduled to be released on that Friday May 11, 2001.
33. That a couple of days later, on May 9, 2001 I was transported to the health center where I was directed to administer a drug urine test.
34. That Corrections Officials told me that my urine tested positive for traces of Marijuana and that I was not going to be released and placed in segregation.
35. That I now fear for my safety.
36. That I fear that if I am transferred to another Correctional Facility I may be harmed or may be killed.
