On December 17, 1985 (Tuesday), Sergeant Joseph Grady and Commander Edward Cisowski (R/A) accompanied Mr. Tom McCulloch to the Pontiac Correctional Center, Pontiac, Illinois. The purpose was to obtain information from BRIAN DUGAN (Inmate #A60862) regarding the JEANINE NICARICO homicide.

Mr. McCulloch, who represents BRIAN DUGAN, said any information obtained would be done through him since no representative from the DuPage County State's Attorney's Office was present. Since no actual interview of DUGAN was conducted, a list of questions was given to Tom McCulloch. These were to be conveyed to BRIAN DUGAN. Mr. McCulloch would, in turn, answer those questions in a "hypothetical manner". The following is the list of the questions given to Tom McCulloch followed by the answers he gave to Sergeant Grady and Commander Cisowski:

1. When did you see the toenail polish on JEANINE NICARICO's toes?

He observed the toenail polish when he moved JEANINE from the front seat to the back seat of the vehicle. McCulloch said JEANINE was lifted over the front seat and placed on the back seat. Her panties were removed as she sat on the seat. When her panties were removed she lifted her knees up towards her chest putting her feet on the seat. At this time "he" could see the nail polish on her toes. He also remembers her bare feet walking on the gravel on the Prairie Path.

2. Describe the polish again.

It was medium pink. The coat or coats seemed to be milky, yet shiny.

3. Did you ever take the blindfold off?

No.

4. If not, how did she walk around the car when it was parked on the Prairie Path?

I had one hand on her arm.

5. Was all evidence actually put into the dumpster?

Yes, except for the shoes and tire iron.

6. Describe exactly where you put the tire iron.
