REQUEST:

At the request of Commander Edward Cisowski, of the Division of Criminal Investigation, Zone 2, the above listed suspect was examined by the polygraph detection of deception technique at the Bureau of Forensic Sciences in Joliet, Illinois, December 2, 1985.

FACTS:

The purpose for this polygraph examination was to investigate whether or not the above listed suspect is telling the truth when he admits to the homicide of Jeanine Nicarico on February 25, 1983. The victim was found beaten to death near a Prairie Path in DuPage County.

RESULTS:

Prior to his examination, the above listed suspect stated that on February 25, 1983 he had kidnapped and killed Jeanine Nicarico. He states he took her from her home in Naperville and left her body near a Prairie Path in DuPage County.

There were no emotional responses indicative of deception on the suspect's polygraph records on the following questions:

1. "On February 25, 1983, did you kick in the door at 620 Clover Court, Naperville and carry Jeanine Nicarico to your car?"

Ans., "Yes."

2. "On February 25, 1983, did you kill Jeanine Nicarico found in that Prairie Path in DuPage County?"

Ans., "Yes."
