

testimony was suggested to me prior to the hearing by Special State's Attorney Russo, and was not true.

G. That at the May 14, 1996 hearing, I testified that Ascensio had said that the only way he could find out if I was a gang member was if an Officer had told him so. In fact, this never occurred.

H. At the May 14, 1996 hearing, I testified that Ascensio asked me if I knew Rolando Cruz, and that I told him, I did.

J. That at the time the December 5, 1995 meeting took place there was a "hit" on Rolando Cruz. That the meeting was scheduled to stop any harm from coming to Rolando Cruz.

K. That at the May 14, 1996 hearing, I testified that Officer RODRIGUEZ "leaned against the back of the bubble so the cameras couldn't see us talking," and that this never happened.

L. That shortly after the December 5, 1995 meeting, I told my attorney Phil Dolci about the meeting. I never gave my attorney permission to disclose this information to anyone.

M. That at the May 14, 1996 hearing, I testified that my attorney initiated a formal complaint at my request to the DuPage County Sheriff's Office. This was untrue I never gave my attorney permission to discuss the information about the meeting with anyone, and I never requested any complaint be brought. I later found out that my attorney had told Don Knoll about the meeting. I did tell my attorney that Deputy RODRIGUEZ had put the meeting together to prevent violence, and told my attorney that I was relieved that no harm would come to Rolando Cruz.

N. That within days of telling my attorney about the December 5, 1995 meeting, I was removed from my cell and taken to a room where Detective Sgt. Wick and Detective Mark Assmusen were waiting.

O. Sgt. Wick told me that my attorney had contacted Don Knoll about them obtaining information about the December 5, 1995 meeting.

P. That I refused to speak with them and asked to be taken back to my cell.

Q. That on December 17, 1995, my mother passed away and Sgt. Wick required me to give information in order to approve a furlough for me to attend my mother's funeral service.
